To the Honorable, the Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity;- The Petition of George Johnson of Frederick County, State of Maryland, Trustee under the Will of Ann P. Marshall, late of said County deceased, for Richard P. Johnson and Mary Gooche Johnson his wife, respectfully shows to your Honors;-

That by the provisions of said last Will said Testatrix bequeathed to your Petitioner the sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars in trust for her Cousin Richard P. Johnson and Mary Gooche Johnson his wife to invest the same and from time to time if necessary to re-invest the same, and upon the further trust to pay the annual income and profits thereof to Richard P. Johnson and Mary Gooche Johnson his wife for and during their lives and the life of the survivor of them, for the maintenance and support of themselves and family as will more fully appear by reference to said Will, a certified copy of which is filed in cause No. 6284 Equity, In the Circuit Court for Frederick County, In Equity, George Johnson Trustee under the Will of Ann P. Marshall for Nannie Marshall Johnson,; On Petition, marked Exhibit No. 1, which said Exhibit together with all exhibits hereinafter produced and referred to, your Petitioner prays may be taken and considered as part of this his petition the same as if set forth in words and figures;-

And after other provisions relating to said trust, said testatrix did by a fourth provision of said Will appoint D. George Johnson and Charles W. Ross Executors of said Will as will appear by reference to said certified copy marked Exhibit No. 1 in said cause No. 6284 Equity;-

Your Petitioner further states that the Executors aforesaid, under the order and direction of the Orphan's Court of Frederick County by an order passed on the 24th day of November, 1890, duly ratified and confirmed March 16, 1891, distributed to your Petitioner Trustees as aforesaid the said sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars in stocks and other securities, including certain ground rents located in Baltimore City, and State of Maryland, as appears from a certified extract of said distribution herewith exhibited marked Exhibit No. 1.

That the Executors aforesaid under and by virtue of the powers and privileges in said Will contained granted and conveyed to said George Johnson Trustee said ground rents mentioned in Exhibit No. 1 forming part of said sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars by deed dated the 12th day of December, 1890, and recorded in Liber J. B. No. 1322, folio 451 &c, one of the Land Records of Baltimore City, a certified copy of which is filed in said cause No. 6284 Equity, marked Exhibit No. 3.

Your Petitioner further states that by virtue of the power given him as Trustee by the provision of said Will to invest said sum of Thirty Thousand Dollars and from time to time if necessary to re-invest the same, he has made the following changes of investments viz;-

That said George Johnson Trustee for and in consideration of the sum of \$1500.00 and accrued rent granted and conveyed to George T. Fowler ground rent No. 725 Dolphin Street, Baltimore by deed dated August 3rd, 1892 and recorded in Liber J. B. No. 1405,
