

To the Honorable Judges of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting as a Court of Equity.

The Petition and Report of Sale of Continental Trust Company, Trustee under a Deed of Trust from McAleer Lime Company, respectfully shows unto your honors.

1. Said Trustee offered at public sale the real estate and personal property aforesaid, the only bid being \$6600.00, the sale was adjourned to the 15th day of November at 12 o'clock at which time the Trustee by its Attorney again offered the said property for sale and there being no other bid the sale was again adjourned until the 30th day of November at which time the Trustee by its Attorney sold the said property of the Continental Trust Company, Trustee, to The LeGore Lime Company for \$6600.00 it being the highest and best bidder therefore, and upon its terms of sale provided by the Deed of Trust and stated in the advertisement of sale to wit; for cash; requiring a deposit of \$2500.00 to insure compliance with the terms of sale.

2. That they took from said purchaser its written acknowledgement of purchase, which is herewith filed and is prayed to be taken as part of this Report of Sale, and also received from them their check for Twenty Five Hundred Dollars \$2500.00 to insure compliance with the terms of sale.

3. And Trustee reports the gross amount of sales to be Six Thousand, Six Hundred Dollars \$6600.00.

Wherefore, your Petitioner prays your honors that said sale, after the publication of the usual order nisi thereon, may be by your Honorable Court finally ratified and confirmed.
