

FIFTH. That all of the parties, and who are the Plaintiffs in this case are adults over twenty-one years of age; that the Defendant, Frank Robert Chase, Junior, in an infant under twenty-one years of age.

SIXTH; That Said real estate described in said "Exhibit C.A.H." is improved by small dwelling house now occupied by a tenant, and with no one in actual possession of the same, and liable to be destroyed and lessened in value, and that said real estate described in said "Exhibit C.A.H." is not susceptible of partition or division among the next of kin or heirs at law without loss or injury to the parties interested.

To the end therefore, your Orators pray:-

1. That your Honors will pass the Decree of your Honorable Court that the real estate described in said "Exhibit C.A.H." be sold by a Trustee to be appointed by your Honorable Court and the money arising from such sale be divided among the parties entitled thereto according to their respective rights.

2. And for such other and further relief to which your Orators are entitled in the premises and as will seem to be just and equitable to your Honors in the premises.

May it please your Honors to grant unto your Orators an Order of publication directed unto the said infant Defendant, Frank Robert Chase, Junior, resident of the District of Columbia, or the writ of subpoena if said infant Defendant will come or be within the jurisdiction of your Honorable Court, commanding him to appear on some certain day in your honorable Court to be named in said order or writ, and answer the premises, and abide by and perform such Order or Decree as may be passed therein by your Honorable Court.
