

cash at the option of the purchaser or purchasers. As soon as may be convenient after making the said sale, the Receivers shall report to this Court under oath a full and particular account of their proceedings under this decree with the name of the purchaser or purchasers, and upon the ratification of the said sale by this Court, and on the payment of the purchase price, and not before, the said Receivers by a good and sufficient deed, to be executed and acknowledged agreeably to law, shall convey to the purchaser or purchasers the property so purchased by him, her, or them, free, clear and discharged of all claims of the parties to this cause and of any person or persons claiming by, from or under them, and the said Receivers shall bring to this Court the money arising from said sales and the bonds and notes which may be taken for the same, to be disposed of under the direction of this Court after deducting therefrom the costs of this suit, counsel fees and such commissions to the said Receivers as this Court shall allow, in consideration of the skill, attention and fidelity wherewith they shall appear to have discharged the duty and trust herein reposed in them.

And it is further ordered and decreed that before the said Receiver proceed to act as such by virtue of this decree and order, they shall give bond to the State of Maryland, in the penalty of Thirty-thousand (\$30,000.00) Dollars with a corporate surety or sureties to be approved by this Court or the Clerk thereof and conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this order and decree, or which may be reposed in them by any further order and decree in the premises.
