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To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court; -

The Petition of Charles W. Held, Assignee of The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, Mortgagee in the hereinafter mentioned Mortgage from Alexander G. Carlisle and Isabel E. Carlisle, his wife, to the said Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, respectfully shows unto your Honors;

First; that the said Alexander G. Carlisle and Isabel E. Carlisle, his wife, being indebted to The Federal Land Bank, of Baltimore in the sum of Twelve Thousand Five Hundred dollars, (\$12,500.) executed their Promissory note for said sum of money on the twenty-third day of May, A. D. 1924, payable in sixty-eight semi-annual payments of Four Hundred Six dollars and Twenty-five cents (\$406.25) each and a final installment of Four Hundred five dollars and thirteen cents, (\$405.13) subject to the Amortization table provided by The Federal Farm Loan Board, which is more fully explained by reference to the Mortgage note submitted herewith and marked as "Exhibit B", and for the purpose of securing the payment of said Promissory note they executed and delivered unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore their Deed of Mortgage granting and conveying unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, as Mortgagee, all the following real estate; lying and being in Lewistown District of Frederick County, Maryland, and being all those two parcels of land, the first containing 196 acres, 3 roods and 19 perches of land, more or less, and the other containing 118 acres, 2 roods and 21 perches, more or less, lying together and containing the aggregate 315 acres and 2 roods, more or less, and being the same land that was conveyed unto Eugene E. Conrad and wife by deed dated April 1st, 1920, and duly recorded in Liber 331 at folio 188, one of the Land Records of Frederick County.
