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The above cause standing ready for a hearing, and being submitted, the Bill, Answer, Exhibits and all other proceedings were by the Court read and considered.

It is thereupon, this 30th day of January in the year nineteen hundred and Twenty-eight by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, as a Court of Equity, and by the authority of said Court adjudged, ordered and decreed, that the land and premises mentioned in these proceedings be sold and that Frank L. Stoner, George R. Dennis Jr and Edgar H. McBride Esquires of Frederick County, be, and are hereby appointed Trustees to make the said sales, and that the course and manner of their proceedings shall be as follows; they shall first file in the Clerk's Office of this Court, a Bond to the State of Maryland, executed by them with a surety, or sureties, to be approved by the Court, or the Clerk thereof, in the penalty of Two Thousand Dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of the trust reposed in them by this decree, or which may be reposed in them by and future order, or decree in the premises they shall then proceed to make sale of the said Real Estate, having first given at least three weeks previous notice, inserted in some newspaper printed in Frederick County, and such other notice as they may think proper of the time, place, manner and terms of sale; which terms shall be as follows; One half cash of the purchase money to be paid in cash on the day of sale, or on the ratification thereof by the Court, the residue in six months the purchaser or purchasers giving his, her, or their notes, with
