

3. Immediately after the deceased of my said wife, I direct that my son, John Morgan, shall be given the sum of \$50.00

4. I give devise and bequeath unto each of my three children born of my first wife, viz., Stella Donsife, Mamie Eyler and Beulah Morgan, the sum of one dollar, they having already received a good portion of my estate, per stirpes.

5. I give devise and bequeath unto each of my seven children by my second wife per stirpes, to be divided among them, share and share alike, all the rest and residue of my estate. I give devise and bequeath my real estate, house and one acre of land in Lewistown Election District, unto my aforesaid seven children by my second wife, Nannie R. Morgan, to hold as they wish and dispose of the same as they wish, but in the event they cannot agree of some should not be of lawful age, my executor shall sell and dispose of the same at Private or Public sale to the highest bidder for cash, and the proceeds shall then be distributed share and share alike, per stirpes, among my aforesaid seven children by my said second wife.

6. I hereby appoint my son, John Morgan, guardian over the estate of any of my infant children, without bond.

7. I hereby constitute and appoint John Morgan, executor of this my Last Will and Testament, without bond, and he shall have authority, to make sales of any portion of my estate without application to the Orphans Court.
