Morgan, Dorothy Morgan Salisbury, Donald Morgan and Kenneth Morgan, mentioned in the titling of the Bill of Complaint, in the body of said Bill and exhibits and in the Testimony, are the same persons mentioned in the residuary clause (No. 5) of the Will, Exhibit E.

Morgan, Dorothy Morgan Salisbury, Donald Morgan, and Kenneth Morgan are the same and only persons referred to in the residuary clause (No. 5) of the Will, Exhibit E."
