To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court;

Your Orators, complaining says:-

1. That Barbara C. Herschel, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, was in her lifetime seized and possessed in fee simple of certain tracts or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in Hauvers District, in Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit;- (1) All that tract or parcel of land that was conveyed to the said Barbara C. Herschel by deed from Gideon Buzzard and wife, said deed bearing date April 6, 1878, and recorded in Liber T.G. No. 2 Folio 264, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, and containing 12 acres, 2 roods and 7 square perches of land, more or less. (2) All that tract or parcel of land that was conveyed to the said Barbara C. Herschel by deed from David A. Herschel bearing date on the 6th day of April in the year 1892, and which said deed is duly recorded among the Land Records of Frederick County, Maryland, said tract containing 3 1/4 acres of land, more or less. Certified copies of said two deeds for the lands therein described being herewith filed and marked "Exhibits A and B," which together with all other exhibits herewith filed are prayed to be taken and considered as a part hereof.

2. That the said Barbara C. Herschel departed this life on or about the _____ day of June, A.D. 1907, intestate, seized and possessed of the above-described tracts or parcels of land, and left surviving her the following children as descendants as her only surviving heirs at law, her husband, David A. Herschel, having died on the 15th day of June A.D. 1929 to whom the above-mentioned and described property descended, to-wit;-

a. Your Orator, the said Hattie M. Bowman, a daughter of the said Barbara C. Herschel, who intermarried with her husband, Herbert C. Bowman, both of whom are of full legal age and reside in Washington County, Maryland.

b. John F. Pote, a son of the said Barbara C. Herschel, who married his present wife, whose name is Lizzie Pote, both of whom are of full age and reside in Turnbull County, Ohio.

c. A daughter, Carrie Uglow, whose husband's name is George Uglow, and said Carrie Uglow having departed this life on or about the _____ day of _____, A.D. 19___ leaving surviving her her husband, the said George Uglow, whose whereabouts is to your Orator unknown, and the following children of the said Carrie J. Uglow born of said marriage, to-wit; (1) Ruth Buzzard, a daughter, whose husband's name is Jesse R. Buzzard, both of whom are adults and reside in Jefferson County, West Virginia (2) Louise Showers, a daughter of the said Carrie Uglow, whose husband's name is Philip Showers, both of whom are adults and reside in Berkeley County, West Virginia, (3) Ethel Jones, a daughter of the said Carrie Uglow, whose husband's name is Curtis Jones, both of whom are adults and reside in Jefferson County, West Virginia, (4) Gladys Grimes, a daughter of the said Carrie Uglow, whose husband's name is George Grimes, both of whom are adults and reside in Jefferson County, West Virginia. (5) Edmond Uglow, a son of the said Carrie Uglow, who is an adult and unmarried and resides in Jefferson County, West Virginia, (6) Austin Uglow a son, of the said Carrie Uglow, who is an infant, under the age of twenty-one years, unmarried and resides in Loudoun County, Virginia.
