This is the Last Will and Testament of one Ann S. Paisley of Frederick City Frederick County Maryland

After the payment of all my funeral charges including a monument to be erected in Mount Olivet Cemetery at the head of my grave on which is to be inscribed the names of myself my husband William Paisley, my daughter Nellie Carns my son Charles E. E. Paisley and my grand daughter May V. Carns said monument not to extend-exceed in cost one hundred and fifty dollars .

I give and devise unto my son George A. Paisley for and during his natural life only The brick house in which I now reside with the lot thereto belonging situated on the north side of West Patrick Street in Frederick City, Frederick County, Maryland and at the death of my said son George A. Paisley, I give and devise said brick dwelling house and the lot thereto belonging to his child or children then living and the issue of any of his children who may then be dead per stripes and not per capita .

I give and bequeath unto my grand daughter Nellie Carns the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10).

All the rest residue and remainder of my estate real personal and mixed wheresoever situated I give devise and bequeath unto my said son George A. Paisley.

And lastly I do hereby constitute and appoint my said son George A. Paisley to be the executor of this my Last Will and testament hereby revoking and annulling all other wills by me heretofore made ratifying and confirming this and none other to be my Last will and testament.

In testimony whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 11th day of February in the year eighteen hundred and ninety three.
