At the request of Mary Crush the following Deed is recorded 11th March 1829 viz.

This Indenture made this twenty eighth day of February in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty-nine between Andrew Heim of Frederick County in the State of Maryland of the one part, and Mary Crush of the County and State aforesaid of the other part.

WITNESSETH; that the said Andrew Heim for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred sixty six dollars current money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said Mary Crush, before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof he the said Andrew Heim doth hereby acknowledge and from every part and parcel thereof dith hereby acquit, exonerate, and discharge, the said Mary Crush her heirs, executors, and administrators, he the said Andrew Heim hath granted bargained, sold, aliened, enfeoffed and confirmed, and by these presence doth grant, bargain, sell, enfeoff, and confirm, unto the said Mary Crush during her natural life and after death to the use and behoof of Margaret Emily and Ann Sophia Emily and should the said Mary Crush survive the said Margaret Emily and Ann Sophia Emily, then to the heirs and assigns of the said Margaret Emily forever. The eastern half of a lot or portion of ground with one-half of the house thereon known and distinguished as lot number twenty-eight lying on the north side of the street called Patrick Street leading from and through Frederick City to Middletown laid off as an additional lot to Frederick City for Jacob Bantz, deceased and being part of a tract of Land Called Longacre, which Longacre being a part of Tasker's Chance beginning for said whole lot at the Southwest corner of lot number twenty-seven, and running thence north fifteen and three-quarter degrees, West two hundred sixty-six feet, then South seventy-four and one -quarter degrees, West forty-two feet then South fifteen and three-quarter degrees, East two hundred sixty-four feet to the Street, thence with said Street to the beginning the said Mary Crush, to have only half, it being the eastern half of said house and Lot, also one-half of the privit on said half lot, and the use of the inlet to said lot in common with Margaret Emily the propriteress of the other half of said lot of ground and house Together with all and singular the buildings, improvements rights, liberties, privilages hereditan ents, and appurtenances, whatsoever belonging, or in any wise appertaining, and the reversions and remainders, rents, issued and profits thereof and all the estate, right titlem and interest, whatsoever, of him the said Andrew Heim, bath at law and in Equity, of into and out, of the said half lot of ground and premises, hereby bargained and sold, or meant, mentioned, or intended here by so to be, and every or any part or parcel thereof To Have and to Hold the said half lot of
