THIRD; That your petitioner also desires to amend the Eleventh Paragraph, by adding, an "s" to the word "Exhibit" and an "s" to the abbreviation, "No" and by also adding the conjunction "and" and the figure "3" in the last line of Paragraph ELEVENTH, so that it shall read "Exhibits Nos 1 and 3."

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays that leave may be granted to him to amend the Bill of Complaint, in the manner, aforesaid, and to file as Exhibit No. 3 a certified copy of the Indenture of February 28, 1929, aforesaid.
