The answer of the Order of the Holy Cross to the supplemental bill of complaint filed in this cause. This respondent answering said bill, answers and states;

That Charles C. Waters, late of Frederick County, deceased, died on or about the Twenty-fifth day of February, Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-Six, leaving a last will and testament, duly probated, admitted and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills for Frederick County, a certified copy of said will is filed as Exhibit "A" to the original Bill of complaint; and that letters testamentary have been granted unto Rosa L.R. Waters, the executrix named in the said will, and that the personal estate of said Charles C. Waters were more than sufficient to pay the debts and funeral expenses of the said Charles C. Waters and has been duly settled and accounted for in the Orphans Court for Frederick County; that the terms and provisions of said will were construed by your Honorable Court in this proceeding and by a decree passed on the First day of October A.D. Nineteen Hundred and Twenty-seven, your Honorable Court adjudged, ordered and decreed "that according to the true construction and intention of the will of Charles C. Waters, deceased, the Order of the Holy Cross, a corporation, is entitled as devisee and legatee in remainder, subject to the legislative sanction as the the realty, to one-half of the residuary estate of the said testator, the widow being entitled to one-half of the said residuary estate by virtue of her renunciation of the will, and that the costs of this proceeding be paid out of the estate." from which order and decree of your Honorable Court John S.
