

advance and pay out of her personal funds the amount of money necessary to pay the said several sums due on account of funeral expenses and Medical Bill of the said Mary A. Barber, and to pay the sum of Fifty Dollars each to the said George A. Barber and Charles B. Barber, after having drawn the said sum of One Hundred Dollars from the Citizens National Bank of Frederick and exhausted it in the payment of the said claim as far as it will go, provided the said sum of money so advanced and paid by her out of her personal funds, can be returned to her out of the proceeds of sale of the said House and Lot when the same is sold.

Your petitioner therefore prays for the following relief;

1. your Honorable Court will take cognizance of said trust that the same may be administered under its authority and jurisdiction.
2. That your petitioner may be authorized to draw from the Citizens National Bank, of Frederick, the said sum of One Hundred Dollars now deposited therein in the name of Mary A. Barber under Deposit Book No. 2405, and apply the same to the payment of the Medical Bill and Funeral Expenses of the said Mary A. Barber.
3. That your petitioner may be authorized and empowered to sell and dispose of the said House and Lot in Middletown, Frederick County, Maryland, mentioned in this petition, whenever she has an opportunity to make an advantageous sale of the same, and that until such sale can be made, she be authorized to pay the remainder of said Funeral Expenses of Mary A. Barber, and the sum of Fifty Dollars each to George A. Barber and Charles B. Barber out of her personal funds, and to reimburse herself with the sum so paid out of the proceeds from the sale of the said House and Lot after the same has been sold and the same ratified by your Honorable Court.
4. And for such other and further relief as the nature and Equity of her case may require.
