FOURTH; That your Petitioner as a tenant in remainder will be entitled to the one-half of said real estate and household furniture and money in bank after the death of said Isadore M.F.Barber.

FIFTH; That the said Isadore M.F.Barber is in and about ninety-one years of age, and is now subject to usual infirmities of her age, and as permitted under the terms of said deed of trust she has not executed a bond for the faithful discharge of her duties as said Trustee, and has not to this time been so required by any Order of your Honorable Court.

SIXTH; That your Petitioner believes it to be necessary for his interest as entitled in remainder to the one-half of said trust estate that now a Bond should be executed by the said Isadore M.F.Barber that will be conditioned for the faithful security of said trust estate, in which your Petitioner has said interest in remainder.

WHEREFORE, your Petitioner prays your Honors for the following reliefs.

FIRST. That your Honors will pass the Order of your Honorable Court directing and requiring the said Isadore M.F.Barber, to execute and deliver to the Clerk of your Honorable Court a good and sufficient Bond, duly approved by your Honorable Court, or the Clerk thereof, conditioned for that said Trustee will faithfully discharge her duties as such and for the conservation of the trust estate now in her possession or control.

SECOND. And for such other and further relief as to your Honors will seem to be just and equitable, and to which your Petitioner will be entitled in the premises.
