I hereby nominate and appoint my husband, William H. Whitmore, to be the Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and I do hereby further appoint my brother, Lewis J. Warner and my Cousin Emory L. Warner, or the survivor, to be the substituted Executors or Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
