SIXTH: I hereby give and bequeath to my widow May Bussard the kitchen cabinet, 2 complete beds and bedding and one coal heating stove, and either rug in the house which she may select one electrical washing machine which shall be hers in trust during her natural life and then revert to my four children or heirs at law.

SEVENTH: It is understood that my daughter Olive Frances Beall shall pay to my widow May Bussard during her natural life \$150.00 one hundred and fifty dollars semiannually making \$300.00 three hundred dollars per year.

EIGHTH: I bequeath to my grandson Richard Lighter one iron safe and such carpenter tools which he may desire.

NINTH: I bequeath my gold watch and chain to my grandson James Wagaman.

TENTH: I bequeath my gold filled watch and chain to my grandson James Beall.

ELEVENTH: I bequeath to my gaughter Olive Frances Beall my electric sweeper.

TWELFTH: I bequeath the remainder of my furniture to my four daughters share and share alike giving them the power to sell what they do not desire.

THIRTEENTH: I bequeath the remainder of my estate to my daughters, Ida E. Lighter, Anna Kate Wagaman, and Mary Wggaman to be divided share and share alike.

FOURTEENTH: I appoint my four daughters Ida E. Lighter, Anna Kate Wagaman, Mary Wagaman, Olive Francis Beall and Joseph H. Bussard as my sole trustees and Executor and Executrices and as I repute great confidence in their honesty and integrity I appoint them without bond.
