The Plea of Olive Frances Beall and Louis C. Beall, of Montgomery County Maryland, to the Bill of Complaint filed against them, et al, in the above entitled Court, respectfully shows unto your Honors:-

These Defendants, by protestation, not confessing or acknowledging all or any part of the matters and things in said Bill of Complaint to be true in manner and form, as the same are thein set forth, for plea nevertheless, to the said Bill, doth plead and aver.

1st. That James O. Bussard, the husband of the Plaintiff in the above Cause and the father of this defendant Olive Frances Beall, died leaving a last Will and Testament, a copy of which said Will is filed in this cause.
