Humerick, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased;- and it is further Ordered by the Court that The Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate, be and it is hereby removed as the Trustee named to carry out the trusts stated in said last Will and Testament of the said Charles O. Humerick, and that Union Bridge Banking and Trust Company, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, located at Union Bridge, in Carroll County, in the State of Maryland, be and it is hereby appointed to be the Trustee with the powers and duties named in the said last Will and Testament, "Exhibit C. O. H." of Charles O. Humerick, deceased, to carry out and perform the duties of Trustee, in place and stead of said The Central Trust Company of Maryland.
