

I give and bequeath unto my daughter, Belva Lockwood Putman, the sum of Eleven Hundred (\$1,100.) Dollars to be hers absolutely.

I give and bequeath unto my daughter Anna Murel Enfield, the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars.

I give and bequeath all the rest and residue of my property, whether the same be real, personal or mixed, of whatsoever kind, and wheresoever located, unto the Central Trust Company of Maryland, with full authority to sell and convey any or all of my aforesaid property in order that it may be converted into cash, in trust and confidence nevertheless, that they will invest the proceeds from the sale thereof in some safe and reliable investment, paying the income and profits arising therefrom in semi-annual installments unto my beloved wife, Maud C. Humerick.

It is my will and I so direct, however, that should my said wife, Maud C. Humerick, elect to continue to make her home after my death in the property where we now reside in Lewistown, Maryland, she shall have the right and privilege to retain said house as her home, together with all the furniture, household effects and my automobile; and should my said wife at the time of my death or thereafter, decide that she no longer desired to continue to make my said residence in Lewistown her home, I then authorize and direct the said Central Trust Company of Maryland, Trustee as aforesaid, to sell and convey said property and the personal effects therein contained, adding the proceeds of said sale to the Trust fund hereinbefore created, for the benefit of my said wife,

At the death of my said wife, Maud C. Humerick, it is my will and I so direct that said Trust shall cease and terminate and I then give and bequeath the corpus of said Trust fund, together with any accumulated interest unto my grandson, Thurston Putman, In the event my said grandson, Thurston E. Putman, shall not have attained the age of twenty-one years at the time of the termination of the Trust hereinbefore created, then I will and direct that the Central Trust Company of Maryland shall act as his guardian until he shall have attained his majority.

Lastly, I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint the Central Trust Company of Maryland, a body corporate of the State of Maryland, as and for the Executor of this my last will and Testament, hereby revoking any and all wills by me heretofore made and ratifying and confirming this and none other as and for my last will and testament.
