And as in duty, etc.

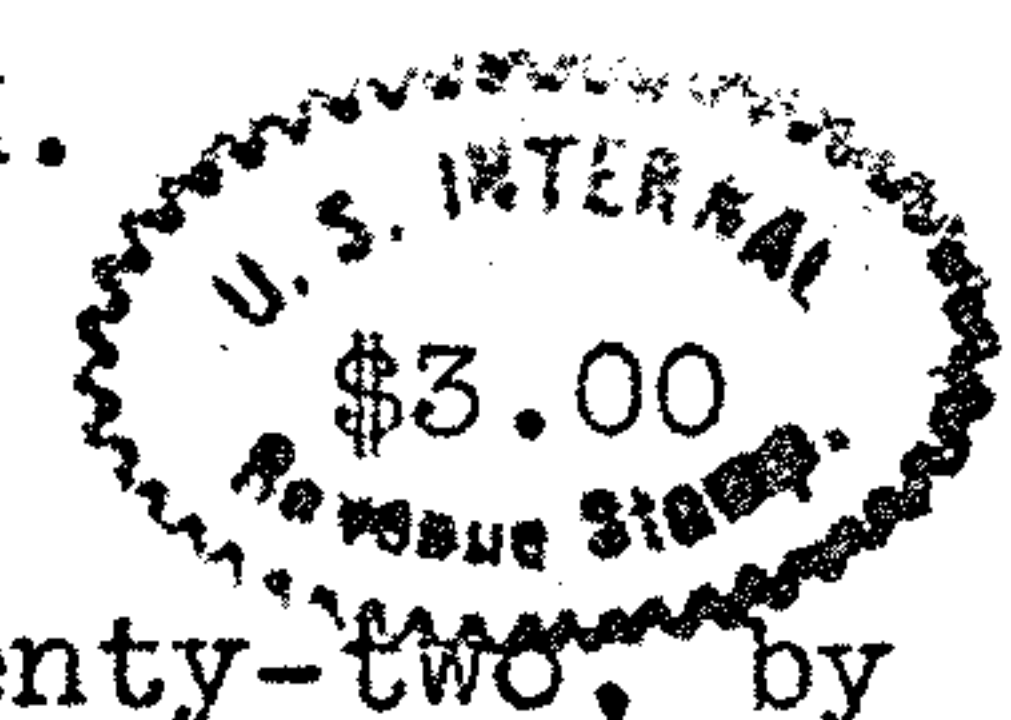

That for the sum of ten dollars and other considerations to us paid, we, the said Raymond L. Crabill and Nona T. Crabill, do hereby grant and convey, in fee simple, unto James H. Orrison, and Alice L. Orrison, his wife, all the following described lot of land located in Brunswick, in said Frederick County, Maryland, to-wit:-

All that lot of land having a frontage of twenty-five feet on the south side of Brunswick Street in W. W. Wenner's First Addition to Brunswick, and a depth of one-hundred and fourteen feet to a twelve foot alley.
