J. HERBERT ORRISON, a witness of lawful age, the Plaintiff in the within cause, having first been duly sworn, produced in his own behalf, deposes and says:-

Examination by Mr. Buckey.

What is your name, age and residence?

James H. Orrison, aged 36 years, and I reside at Brunswick, Maryland, where I have lived for about sixteen years.

Have you any employment, and if so, what?

A fireman for the B. & O.

For how long have you been fireman for the B. & O. railroad?

About 16 years.

During that time you have lived in Brunswick, Maryland.

Yes.

You were married to Alice Louise Orrison when?

January 31, 1922.

You have since obtained a divorce from her?

Yes, sir, by a decree of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, filed on February 25, 1930, in No. 12,001 Equity.

After you married you acquired a piece of property in Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, a certified copy of the deed therefor being filed in this case as Exhibit No. 1, will you look at the deed and see if it correctly describes the property?

Yes, this is the property.

You had this deed for the property made to both you and your wife?

Yes sir.
