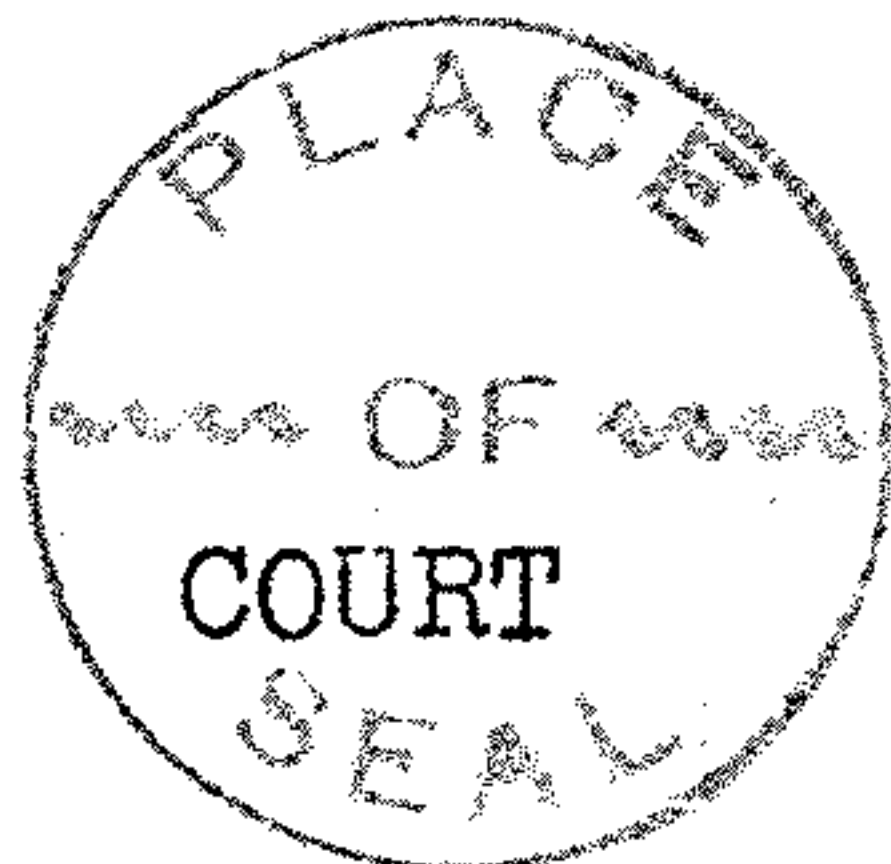

THIS DEED, made this 10th day of April in the year nineteen hundred and thirty-one, by Hugh L. Pope, Trustee by virtue of an Order of the Circuit Court, of Baltimore City, as hereinafter recited, party of the first part, and Hugh L. Pope, Trustee under a certain deed of trust hereinafter mentioned, party of the second part, unto Frederick May Gittings of Baltimore City in the State of Maryland, party of the third part;

WHEREAS, by an Order of the Circuit Court of Baltimore City in the case of John S. Gittings vs. Henry May Gittings et al, (Docket 44-A folio 446) the said Hugh L. Pope, party of the first part, was appointed the trustee (succeeding John S. Gittings), for the further administration of the trust created by the Decree in the said case, and has duly qualified as such trustee; and

WHEREAS by a Deed from Frederick May Gittings to him, dated the 22nd day of January, in the year 1923, and recorded among the Land Records of Baltimore City in Liber S. C. L. No. 3963 Folio 364 &c., the said Frederick May Gittings did grant and convey to said Hugh L.
