Gorsuch his wife her heirs and assigns all his property and estate lands and tenements of every kind and nature real personal and mixed and wheresoever situated, together with all notes, stocks, mortgages and other securities belonging to him.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all of said property and estate of every kind and nature unto the said Ann M. Gorsuch her heirs and assigns in trust and special confidence nevertheless and to for and upon the uses and to the ends intents and purposes hereinafter expressed that is to say: In trust that the said Peregrine Gorsuch shall have hold use occupy and possess said property and estate and every part thereof for and during the residue of his natural life and the rents, issues and income and profits thereof to take and apply to his own use and benefit without impeachment of waste with full power and authority to the said Peregrine Gorsuch at any time during the residue of his natural life and without the consent of the said Ann M. Gorsuch or any person or persons hereinafter named to sell lease mortgage and dispose of said property or any part thereof in any way he may see proper and apply the proceeds thereof to his own use and benefit and from and immediately after the death of the said Peregrine Gorsuch then the said property and estate and every part thereof or so much thereof as shall not have been disposed of by the said Peregrine Gorsuch during his life to go to the said Ann M. Gorsuch for and during the residue of her natural life or widowhood the rents issues and profits thereof to take and apply to her own use and benefit with full power and authority to the said Ann M. at any time during the residue of her natural life to sell lease or dispose of said property or any part thereof and execute a deed or deeds for the same and the proceeds arising from any sale or sales to invest for the benefit of the said estate the
