Seventeenth And your complainants further state that they are informed that they are entitled to have the said deeds from the said Ann M. Gorsuch to the said Elizabeth A. Gorsuch set aside and declared void by this Court as against your Complainants.

To the end therefore that the said John T. Gorsuch Theodore Gorsuch and M. Georgiana Gorsuch his wife, Daniel H. Gorsuch and Susanna C. Gorsuch his wife, Washington Gorsuch and Mary J. Gorsuch his wife Silas M. Gorsuch and Elizabeth Gorsuch his wife, Lewis C. Gorsuch and Mary T. Gorsuch his wife, Elizabeth A. Gorsuch, Julia A. McCormick and John H. McCormick her husband, Ann M. Gorsuch and the said Eleventh German American Building Association of Baltimore City may answer the several matters and things hereinbefore stated, that the said deeds from the said Ann M. Gorsuch to the said Elizabeth A. Gorsuch may be by a decree of this Court set aside and declared void and that the said lots of ground and parcels of land may be sold and the said mortgage held by the said Body Corporate paid, and that your complainants may have such other and further relief as their case may require.

May it please your Honor to grant unto your complainants the State's writ of sub poena directed to John T. Gorsuch, Theodore Gorsuch and M. Georgiana Gorsuch his wife, Daniel H. Gorsuch and Susanna C. Gorsuch his wife, Washington Gorsuch and Mary J. Gorsuch his wife, Silas W. Gorsuch and Elizabeth Gorsuch his wife Lewis C. Gorsuch and Mary T. Gorsuch his wife Elizabeth A. Gorsuch, Julia A. McCormick and John H. McCormick her husband Ann M. Gorsuch and the Eleventh German American Building Association of Baltimore City commanding them and it to be and appear in this Honorable Court on some day certain to be therein named to answer abide by and perform such order or decree as may therein be passed.
