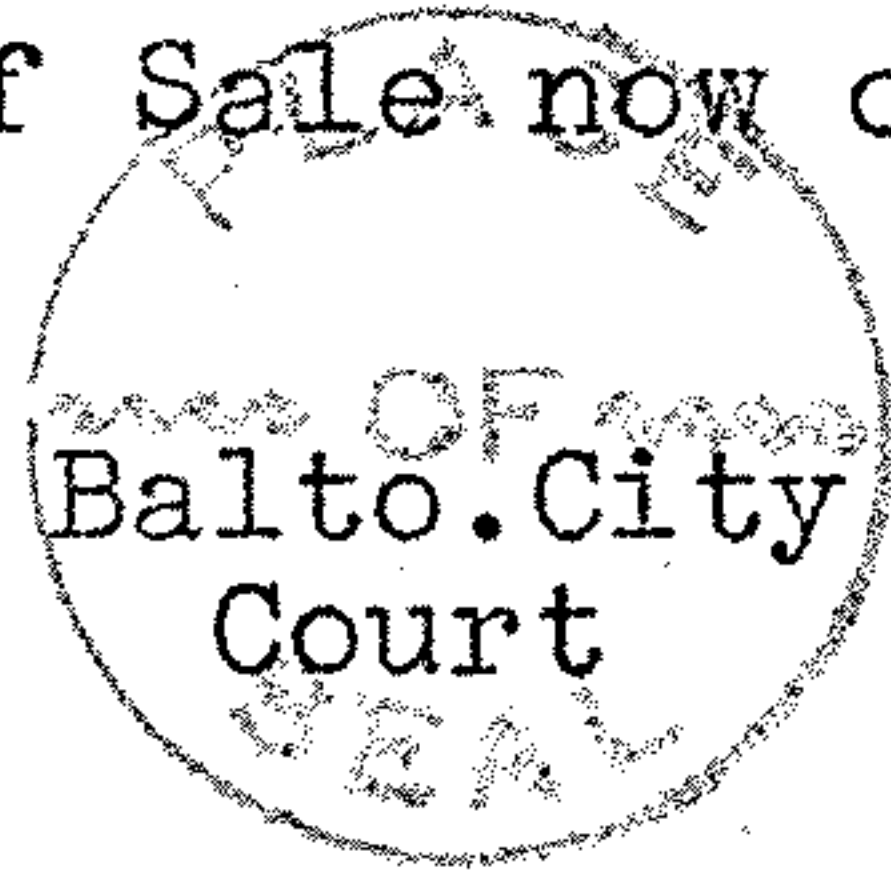

The Petition of Charles W. Held, Assignee of The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, Mortgagee in the hereinafter mentioned Mortgage from Raymond Monroe Brashear, a widower, to the said The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, respectfully shows unto your Honors:-

First, that the said Raymond Monroe Brashear, a widower, being indebted to The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore in the sum of Twenty-two Hundred Dollars (\$2200.00) executed his Promissory note for the said sum of money on the 17th day of January, A. D. 1929, payable in Seventy-one semi-annual payments of Sixty-six Dollars (\$66.00) each and a final installment of One Hundred two Dollars and thirty-one Cents (\$102.31) subject to the Amortization table provided by The Federal Farm Loan Board, which is more fully explained by reference to the Mortgage note submitted herewith and marked as "Exhibit A", and for the purpose of securing the payment of said Promissory note he executed and delivered unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore his Deed of Mortgage granting and conveying unto The Federal Land Bank of Baltimore, as Mortgagee, all the following real estate, land and premises, to wit:- "Those three certain tracts or parcels of land lying partly in Mt. Airy election district, Carroll County, and partly in Woodville electbn district, Frederick County, in the State of Maryland, described as follows:

Tract No. 1: BEGINNING at a stone planted at the end of a line of "The Valley of Strife" said stone being marked "32" and standing near Cornelius Brashear's tobacco house, and running thence binding on the line of a conveyance from Osburn Brashear to Cornelius Brashear N. 57 deg. W. 28 perches; N. 38 deg. E. 35 perches to a stone now planted; then N. 76 3/4 deg. W. 82 1/2 perches to the center of the Buffalo Road; thence binding thereon S. 7 1/2 deg. W. 18 perches; S. 14 1/4 deg. W. 46 perches S. 11 3/4 deg. W. 44 perches; S. 18 3/4 deg. W. 34 perches; then S. 64 deg.
