

No. 2" may be sold by a trustee for the purpose of paying the claims of your Orators, and of any other creditors, if there be such, of the said William Johnson, deceased.

Second: And for such other further and general relief as your Orators may be entitled in the premises, and as unto your Honors will appear to be just and equitable.

May it Please your Honors to grant unto your Orators the writ of Subpoena directed unto the said Alice Johnson, resident of Frederick County, Maryland, commanding her to be and appear, either in person or by solicitor in your Honorable Court, on or before a certain date to be named therein, to answer the Bill of Complaint and to show cause, if any she has why a decree ought not to be passed as prayed. And as in duty bound etc.

At the request of William Johnson the following Deed is received for Record and Recorded January 3, 1888 at 2 o'clock P. M.

This Deed made this ninth day of August in the year eighteen hundred and Eighty Seven by Maria Johnson of Frederick County, in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of the sum of One hundred and five dollars, the said Maria Johnson doth grant in fee simple unto William Johnson of Frederick County aforesaid all that lot or parcel of land situated, lying and being in Frederick County in the State of Maryland, being part of the same land which was conveyed to Giles Livers by deed dated May 25th, 1844 and recorded in Liber H. S. folio 522, one of the land records of Frederick County. Beginning at the end of 30 52/100 perches on the western side of Lot No. 8 and running with it South twenty eight and a half degrees west twenty-seven and a half perches to a stone at the beginning of Lot No. 8, north seventy one degrees west five and thirty two hundredths perches to the beginning of the third line of an adjoining lot which the said William Johnson obtained from said Maria Johnson by deed dated July 13th, 1887, and running with said third line north twenty eight and a half degrees east twenty nine and seven tenths perches to the county road called Bridle road thence South forty seven degrees east to first beginning. Containing one acre of land, more or less.
