- Q Did you know the name of Miss Lulu's mother?
- A Uncle John's first wife?
- Q Yes?
- A Yes.
- Q What was her first name?
- A Drusilla.
- Q You know whether she had any sisters or brothers?
- A No, I did not.
- Q Never heard of any of them?
- A No, sir.
- Q And when you would talk about the family to Miss Lulu you would talk about the Heffner side?
- A We were always talking together but never talked about that side.
- Q You are one of the heirs so far in this estate?
- A Yes, sir.
- Q You are one of the distributees?
- A And I am half brother of Johnny, a step brother, by his second wife, of Lewis Heffner.
- Q You are a son of Lewis?
- A Yes, brother of Uncle John.
- Q What relation was John to Lewis?
- A Brother.
- Q I thought you said step brother?
- A No, little John, the one that died on the farm.
- Q You are one of the heirs up to this date that is going to get this estate, that right?
- A That's right.
