Order of Publication.

The object of this suit is to procure a decree of Court for the sale of the real estate of the late Somerset W. Draper, for the purpose of paying his funeral expenses etc.,

The Bill of Complaint alleges that Somerset W. Draper, late of Frederick County, Maryland, deceased, departed this life, intestate, on or about the 1st day of August, 1930, seized and possessed of all that lot of land, located in Catoclin District, in said Frederick County, containing eight acres of land, more or less, and being the same real estate which was conveyed to the said Somerset W. Draper from Julia Kelbaugh, by deed dated on the 13th day of March, 1879, and recorded in Liber No. 296, at folio 446, one of the land records for said Frederick County, and left surviving him, as his only heirs at law, the following named children: to wit: Samuel Draper, whose wife's name is Mae Draper; Bertha Stotelmyer, whose husband's name is Welty Stotelmyer; Dessie Huntzberry, whose husband's name is Daniel Huntzberry; Norman Draper, whose wife's name is Ona V. Draper; John Wetzel whose wife's name is Ada Wetzel, and Dewey Draper.

That said Somerset W. Draper's estate is indebted to your complainant, Emory Frey, in the sum of one hundred and thirty-one dollars for funeral expenses, and that said Somerset W. Draper died without leaving sufficient personal property to pay his debts and no administration on his estate has been granted.

That all of said defendants are residents of Frederick County, Maryland, excepting Daniel Huntzberry and Dessie Huntzberry, who are non residents of the State of Maryland, and are now residing at Leaf River, in Ogle County, Illinois, and the said John Wetzel and Ada Wetzel, who are also non residents of the State of Maryland, and are now residing in Rockford, Illinois.

The bill then prays for a decree of Court for the sale of the real estate of said Somerset W. Draper, by a trustee to be appointed by the Court for the payments of the debts of said decedent and for general relief.

It is thereupon, ordered this 6th day of January, 1932, by the Circuit Court for Frederick County, sitting in Equity, and by the authority thereof, that the complainant, Emory Frey, by causing a copy of this order to be inserted in some newspaper, published in said Frederick County, once a week for four successive weeks, prior to the 6th day of February, 1932, give notice to the said non resident defendants, Daniel Huntzberry and Dessie Huntzberry, his wife, and John Wetzel and Ada Wetzel, his wife, of the object and
