To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The Petition of D. Princeton Buckey, Holden S. Felton and Alton Y. Bennett, Trustees in the above-entitled cause, respectfully represents unto your Honors:

1- That your Petitioners were appointed Trustees by a decree of your Honorable Court in the above-entitled cause, to make sale of the real estate therein mentioned and described, of which John W.
