To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The Petition and Additional Report of John W. Obenderfer and D. Princeton Buckey, Receivers in the above-entitled cause, respectfully shows:

1- That your Petitioners heretofore, to-wit: on the 10th day of February, 1933, filed a Report and "Inventory and Appraisement" of all of the property and assets of The Obenderfer-Dronenburg Company, a body corporate, as Receivers of said Company, that has come into their hands and of which they have any knowledge, the total and aggregate value and amount thereof being Fourteen thousand five hundred and forty-five and 50/100 dollars (\$14,445.50); all of which will more fully appear to your Honorable Court by reference to Exhibit "Inventory and Appraisement," etc., filed with said Report.

2. That the total debts, claims and liabilities due against the said The Obenderfer-Dronenburg Company, a body corporate, the Defendant, and filed upon the "Claim Docket" in the office of the Clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick County, Maryland, pursuant to Exhibit "Notice to Creditors" filed in this cause and which time for the filing of claims expired on February 11, 1933, aggregate the sum of Nineteen thousand, three hundred and ninety-eight and 15/100 dollars (\$19,398.15).

3- That Frederick W. Obenderfer, the Plaintiff in this cause, is co-maker and endorser on two Single Bills filed in this cause, one for \$12,200.00 to the Fredericktown Savings Institution, and one for \$3,737.80 to the Citizens National Bank of Frederick, given by the Obenderfer-Dronenburg Company, the Defendant, and must pay the same as he is the only responsible party liable therefor.

4- That some of the furniture and a large number of the installment accounts, as well as many other accounts due, are not salable or collectible at this time, without great sacrifice in value and money, and if a forced sale or auction of the personal property or real estate were required or made, the said Frederick W. Obenderfer would suffer and sustain much financial loss.
