To the Honorable, the Judges of said Court:

The Petition and Report of Sales of John W. Obenderfer and D. Princeton Buckey, Receivers in the above-entitled cause, respectfully shows unto your Honors:

1- That pursuant to Petition and Additional Report, Exhibit "Offer of Purchase" filed in the above cause, and the Order of your Honorable Court passed thereon on the 17th day of February, 1933, your Petitioners, by the authority conferred upon them, have sold unto Frederick W. Obenderfer at and for the sum of Nineteen thousand, three hundred and ninety-eight and 15/100 dollars (\$19,398.15), all of the property and assets belonging to The Obenderfer-Dronenburg Company, including furniture and stock in trade, debts due said Company, office furniture, stocks and the equity value of real estate, all of which is contained in Exhibit "Inventory and appraisement", etc., heretofore filed in this cause on the 10th day of February, 1933, and for the further consideration that the said Frederick W.
