

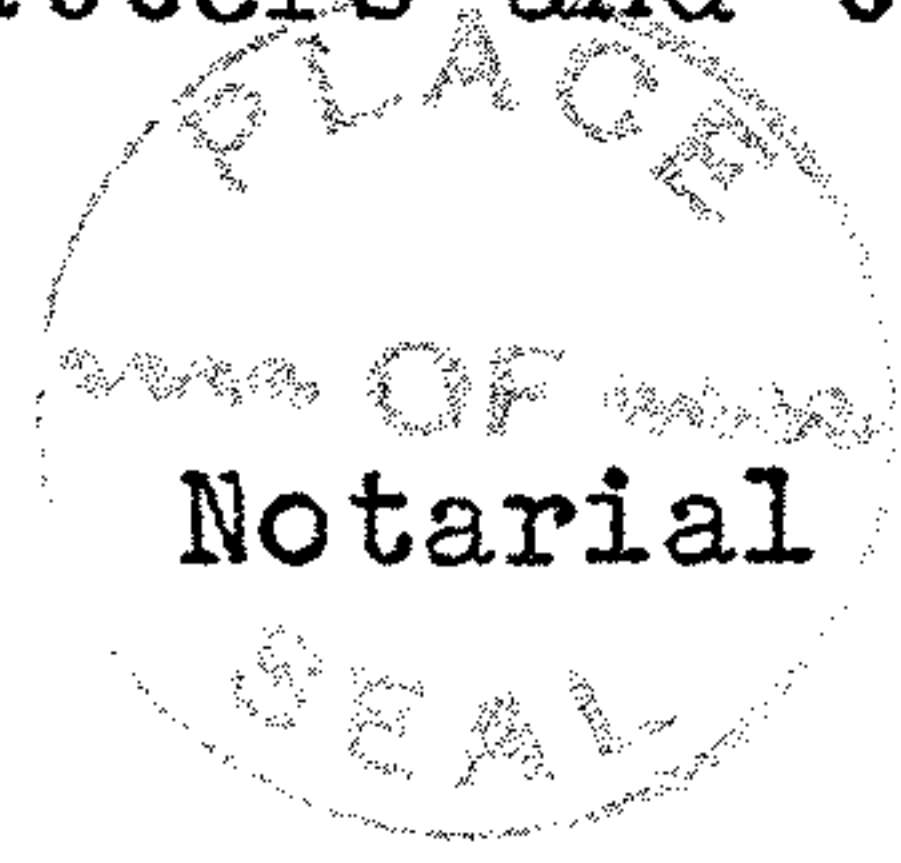

At the request of Edgar L. Annan the following deed is received for record and recorded Sept. 20, 1912, at 8.30 o'clock A. M.

This Deed made this 31st day of August, in the year Nineteen Hundred and twelve (1912) between J. Granville Miller and his wife Mary M. Miller, of Hanover Borough, County of York, and State of Pennsylvania, of the first part, and Edgar L. Annan, of Emmitsburg, Maryland of the Second part;-

WITNESSETH: that in consideration of the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2000.00) in hand paid, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said grantors, does hereby grant, and convey to the said grantee, all that the following piece, parcel or tract of land, situate, lying and being in the Hampton Valley, Frederick County, and State of Maryland, and Known as tract called "Wee Archey, and part tract called, Carolina, Bounded and limited as follows; to wit;- Beginning for a corner at a public road, running from Emmitsburg to Harbaughs Valley, thence along said road, in a southwesterly direction to a stake at a corner of land, of Mr. Moot, thence along the said Moots land, in a North Westerly direction, to a stone or Corner, at land of George Anderson, Thence along said Anderson Land, in a North Easterly direction, to a stone or Corner of land, of Columbus Springer thence along said Springer Land, in an Easterly direction, to a stone or Corner at land formerly Wagerman's thence along said land in a South easterly direction, to a stone or corner at land of same, thence in a Southerly direction, to a stone or Corner at land of Mr. Watt, thence along and with the same to the Place of Beginning, Containing One Hundred and Twenty Three acres of Land, more or less. It being part of the same tract, of land which was sold and conveyed unto the said J. Granville Miller, by William R. Bell, during his life time, by his deed duly executed and bearing date,
