This Deed Made this 17th day of February in the year 1906 by James O. Harne of Frederick County in the State of Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of five dollars and Natural love and Affection I do grant and convey unto my beloved wife Annie M. Harne all that part of a tract of land called "Stony Lick" and part of a tract called "Bruces Range" situated in Frederick County Maryland. Beginning for the same or the first parcel at the beginning of a deed from Samuel P. Bussard and Florence M. Bussard his wife to James O. Harne for 120 $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of land, more or less, for courses and distances reference to Land Record of Frederick County will more fully appear and said deed dated 20th day of March 1885 & recorded April 3rd A. D. 1885 in Liber A. F. No. 11, Folio 7 &c., one of the Land Records of Frederick County Maryland.

Beginning for the 2nd. parcel of an original tract of land called Hide & Seek said parcel being part of said tract and beginning for the same at the beginning of the 5th line of the whole tract called Hide and Seek and running thence with said 5th line allowing 3° for variation North 21 $\frac{1}{2}$ ° E. 174 Ps. to the beginning of a tract of land called "Bruces Range" thence North 63° East 130 Ps. thence South 8° E. 5 Ps. then South 14 Ps. then South 63 West 112 Ps. then South 63 West 170 Ps. then by a straight line to the beginning Containing 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ acres of land more or less.
