Bussard trustees of Samuel Bussard Deceased being also the same lot conveyed to me By William Toms and Annie M. Toms his wife by a Deed dated June 1st A. D. 1898, and recorded in Liber D. H. H. Folio 687, one of the land records of Frederick County containing 23 and 11/160 acres more or less.

This Deed made this Tenth day of April in the year nineteen hundred and six By James O. Harne of Frederick County Maryland. Witnesseth that in consideration of One Dollar and Love and affection I the said James O. Harne do hereby grant and convey unto my beloved Wife Annie M. Harne all of the following Parcels of Land situated in Frederick County Maryland. First all that part of a tract or parcel of land known as the Saw Mill tract on which stood the Old Bussard Saw Mill and lying east of the County Road. Being part of a Parcel of land conveyed to me by Samuel P. Bussard and wife and was recorded March 2th 1896 in Liber J.L.J. No. 11 Folio 613 Containing about 10 acres of Land more or less. Also all that Parcel of Land Beginning for the same at a Post near a Gum tree marked six notches and near a spring close to the Public Road and running thence N 46° E. 34 ps. to a pile of stones N 28° W. 114 ps. to a Pin oak tree S 78° E 17.2 ps. to a pile of stones S 18 3/4° W 38.4 ps. N 89° W 22 ps. to the place of beginning Containing 3 acres of land more or less.
