Harne all the following Parcels of Land which was conveyed unto me by Cyrus C. Shuff and Wife Joseph Stottlemeyer and wife John Kelbaugh and wife and Henson C. Draper and Wife and recorded in Liber W.I.P. No. 6, Folio 126 April 4th. 1888, Liber W.I.P. No. 11, Folio 27, Feb. 27th. 1890, Liber J.L.J. No. 5, Folio 110, June 10th 1893, and in Liber J.L.J. No. 5, Folio 428 December 19th. 1893 all of which are among the Land Records of Frederick County. Also all that parcel of Land adjoining on the South west corner the whole comprize of the above named several parcels and being lot No. 8, on the Plat of the Gideon Bussard tract of 125 acres which was deeded to me the said James O.
