Witnesseth that in consideration of Thirty six dollars and fifty cts. the said Henry Show doth grant unto James O. Harne all that tract or parcel of land situated in the County and State aforesaid, being part of a tract of land called Hide & Seek. Beginning for the part to be conveyed at the beginning of the 5th line of the whole tract and running thence with said 5th line allowing  $3\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  for variation, N  $21\frac{1}{2}^{\circ}$  E 174 ps. to the beginning of a tract of land called Bruce's Range then N  $63^{\circ}$  E 130 ps. then S  $8^{\circ}$  E 5 ps. then S 14 ps. then S  $63^{\circ}$  W 112 then S  $63^{\circ}$  W 170 then by a straight line to the Beginning, Containing  $36\frac{1}{2}$  acres of land more or less.
