This Deed made this Third day of June in the year Eighteen hundred and ninety five by Benjamin Shuff of the County of Frederick in the State of Maryland, Witnesseth that in consideration of Forty dollars said Benjamin Shuff doth sell unto James O. Harne of said County and Stat, all that parcel of land which said Shuff purchased of Cornelius Duple in a deed bearing date Feb. 2nd, 1891 the same being part of a tract of land called What You Please, beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at the end of the third line of What You Please and running thence to the end of the 10th line of What You Please, viz. 57° W. 84 ps. to a stone planted S. 65° W. 62 ps. to a stone planted, S. 23° E. 28 ps. to a stone planted, N. 65° E. 62 ps. to a Locust stake and a pile of stones S. 83° E. 65 ps. to a stone planted N. 51° E. 34 ps. to a stone, N. 25° E. 34 ps. thence across said land by a course and distance N. 37 1/4° W. 15 3/4 ps. to the place of beginning; containing 35 3/4 acres of land more or less.
