W. D. L. Harne and Katie S. Harne, his wife, and all other complainants in the original Bill of Company in the above entitled cause respectfully shows unto your Honors:-

1. That pursuant to the order of your Honorable Court dated the 22nd day of January, 1929, your Petitioners amend their Bill of Complaint filed in the above entitled cause, as follows:

A. By inserted after sub-Paragraph D in Paragraph 4, an additional paragraph to be designated as Paragraph 4, D, 1,

All that piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, containing 3 acres of land, more or less, which was conveyed unto Annie M. Harne by James O. Harne, by deed dated April 10, 1906, and recorded in Liber S.T.H. 276, Folio 87, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, mentioned and described in the foregoing certified copy of deed marked Exhibit D.

2. Your Complainants further amend their Bill of Complaint by inserting an additional paragraph after sub-Paragraph J of Paragraph 5, to be known as Paragraph 5K,

All that piece or parcel of land containing 3 acres of land, more or less, situate, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, which was conveyed unto the said James O. Harne by W. H. C. Russman and Lillie A. Russman, his wife, by deed dated April 13, 1894, and recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 5, Folio 718, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, a certified copy of which deed is filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit R.

3. By adding a paragraph following sub-Paragraph B in Paragraph 6, to be designated as Paragraph 6C,

All that piece or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Frederick County, Maryland, containing 12 acres of land, more or less, and being designated as Lot No. 10 as laid out by the said James O. Harne and being a part of all that 125 acres which was conveyed unto the said James O. Harne by Thaddeus Bussard and Emory L. Coblentz, Trustees, by deed dated July 5, 1902, and recorded in Liber D. H. H. No. 15, Folio 9, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, a certified copy of which said deed is filed herewith as a part hereof and marked Exhibit S.

4. That they further amend the Bill of Complaint by adding an additional paragraph
