This Mortgage made this 8th day of February in the year A. D. Eighteen hundred and Ninety-eight, by us, James O. Harne and Annie M. Harne, his wife, of Frederick County, and State of Maryland. Witnesseth: That we the said James O. Harne and Annie M. Harne, his wife, being indebted to Charles Wertheimer of the said county and State, in the sum of Twenty Five Hundred Dollars, as witnessed by our Joint and several single bill of even date herewith payable one year after date, with interest. Now therefore in consideration thereof, and the payment to us of the sum of Five Dollars, by the said Charles Wertheimer, the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we, the said James O. Harne and Annie M. Harne, his wife, do grant unto the said Charles Wertheimer all those pieces or parcels of land, lying and being in Frederick County and State of Maryland, together with all the improvements thereon, and all the rights, ways and appurtenances thereto belonging or in any manner appertaining, said pieces or parcels of land being as follows: First, all that piece or parcel of land conveyed by deed dated March twentieth, 1885, from Samuel P. Bussard and wife, to the said James O. Harne, containing one hundred and twenty acres of land, more or less, and known as the home place, which deed is recorded in Liber A. F.
