SECOND: That the Trustees' account of receipts and disbursements of income up to April 17th, 1932, filed with the Bill of Complaint as Complainants' Exhibit No. 5, be and the same is hereby finally ratified and confirmed.

THIRD: That by the true construction of the Will of the said Luther B. Ditch, all of the properties forming a part of the corpus of the trust estate under the Will of the said Luther B. Ditch, known as Nos. 11, 13 and 15 East Twenty-First Street, together with the buildings in the rear of said properties on the west side of Lovegrove Alley, as well as the building in the rear of said properties on the east side of Lovegrove Alley, and the entire lot of ground at the southeast corner of St. Paul and Twenty-Fifth Streets, known as No. 101 East Twenty-Fifth Street, together with the store buildings and housekeeping apartment erected on said lot in the rear of the main building, passed to the Defendant Winfield Scott Ditch upon the termination of the trust estate herein under the Fifth clause of the said Will of the said Luther B. Ditch.

FOURTH: That the trust estate herein terminated upon the death of Martha Alice Ditch on April 17th, 1932, and the corpus thereof is distributable to the parties entitled thereto in accordance with the Will of the said Luther B. Ditch, and that the Trustees' Amended Distribution Account filed in these proceedings and marked, "Exhibit Examiner No. 6", whereby the said corpus of the said trust estate is distributed to the parties entitled thereto respectively, with the exception of that part of the corpus of said trust estate reserved in and by said Amended Distribution Account to be distributed to the parties entitled thereto, as tenants in common, and to be sold to pay the costs of this proceeding, etc. be and the same is hereby finally ratified and confirmed, and each of the parties hereto shall hold the shares of said trust estate allotted to him or her by said Amended Distribution Account in severalty, and not in common with the other parties hereto.

FIFTH That the fee-simple property at Blue Ridge Summit, Pennsylvania improved by a summer cottage, and mentioned and referred to in these proceedings, shall be held by Winfield Scott Ditch, as to a six thirty-sixth interest therein, Margaret Alice Ford, as to a six thirty-sixth interest therein, George E. Eddy, as to a six thirty-sixth interest therein, Caroline Kay as to a two thirty-sixth interest therein, Florence Wright, as to a two thirty-sixth interest therein, Purnell N. Ditch, as to a two thirty-sixth interest therein, Clara B. Taylor, as to a three thirty-sixth interest therein, Marie Swink, as to a three thirty-sixth interest therein, Maude E. Rogers, as to a three thirty-sixth interest therein and E. Lawrence Ditch, as to a three thirty-sixth interest therein, their heirs and assigns, as tenants in common.

SIXTH: That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Substituted Trustees herein, shall distribute, transfer and set over to the parties, and in the proportions set forth in the preceding paragraph of this Decree, the forty-six shares of Blue Ridge Water Company stock.

SEVENTH: That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Substituted Trustees herein, shall sell for the most money that they can obtain for the same, either at public or private sale, but if at private sale for not less than the value of the same as set forth in the said Trustees' Amended Distribution Account, the following:
