And immediately thereafter, the said Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Substituted Trustees as aforesaid, shall return to this Court a full and particular account of their sales of said securities, ground rents and jewelry and of their proceedings hereunder.

EIGHTH: That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Substituted Trustees herein, shall pay out of the corpus of this trust estate the sum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) to the income of this trust estate, in re-payment of the loan made by said income to said corpus on December 16th 1931, as shown by the Trustees' account of receipts and disbursements of corpus filed herein as Complainants' Exhibit No. 2.

NINTH: That the proceeds of the sales provided for in the Seventh paragraph of this Decree shall be distributed in the manner provided for by the Seventh Paragraph of the Agreement of the parties dated December 20, 1932, filed in these proceedings.

TENTH: That Watson E. Sherwood, Enos S. Stockbridge and Harry D. Kaufman, Esquires, be and they are hereby allowed a counsel fee of \$2,000.00 for their services to this estate as set out in the Third Paragraph of the Agreement of the parties herein dated December 20, 1932, and filed in these proceedings as Exhibit Examiner No. 4.

ELEVENTH: That Messrs. Niles, Barton, Morrow & Yost be and they are hereby allowed a counsel fee of \$3,500.00 for their services to this estate as set out in the Fourth Paragraph of the said Agreement of the parties dated December 20, 1932, and filed in these proceedings as Exhibit Examiner No. 4.

TWELFTH: That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow Substituted Trustees herein, be and they are hereby allowed a fee of \$1,500.00 for special services in distributing the corpus of the trust estate herein as set out in the Fifth Paragraph of the said Agreement of the parties dated December 20, 1932, and filed in these proceedings as Exhibit Examiner No. 4.

THIRTEENTH: That upon complying with all the requisites of this Decree upon their part to be performed, the said Winfield S. Ditch Jr. and Chester F. Morrow shall be released and discharged as Trustees herein.

AND BE IT FURTHER ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Trustees herein, be and they are hereby directed to transfer to Winfield Scott Ditch, Margaret Alice Ford and George E. Eddy, Executor of Mary C. Eddy (a one-sixth interest to each), Maude E. Rogers, E. Lawrence Ditch, Clara B. Taylor and Marie Swink (a one-twelfth interest to each), Caroline Kay, Florence Wright and Purnell N. Ditch (a one-eighteenth interest to each) 46 shares of the capital stock of the Blue Ridge Water Company.

AND BE IT FURTHER ADJUDGED, ORDERED AND DECREED That Winfield S. Ditch, Jr. and Chester F. Morrow, Trustees herein, be and they are hereby directed to transfer to the purchaser or purchasers thereof, under decree of this Court for the sale thereof, the following securities:

8 shares, Finance Company of America, Class A, Common Stock;

10 shares, National Discount Company, Common Stock;

2 shares, Investment Holding Corporation, Common Stock.
