

The Answer of D. CHESTER KEMP, Executor of the Last Will and Testament of Anna S. Kemp, deceased, to the Bill of Complaint of D. Chester Kemp and Sophie Kemp. his wife, in your Honorable Court exhibited against this Defendant and others.

THIS RESPONDENT SAYS:

First: That he admits the allegations contained in the First, Second, Third, Fourth, Fifth and Sixth Paragraphs of said Bill of Complaint.

Second: That he also admits that a question has arisen as to the proper construction of the Last Will and Testament of Anna S. Kemp, deceased, of which this Respondent is the Executor.

Third: That he admits, as shown by the Inventories filed in the Orphans' Court, the home farm is appraised at Twenty Thousand Dollars (\$20,000), as alleged in the Eighth Paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, and as to the remaining allegations in said Eighth Paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, he submits the same to your Honorable Court for your consideration and determination, as to a proper construction of the Last Will and Testament of the said Anna S. Kemp, deceased.

Fourth: That he admits the allegations contained in the Ninth Paragraph of said Bill of Complaint.

Fifth: That as to the Tenth Paragraph of said Bill of Complaint, he believes it would be to the interest and advantage of all the parties, and especially to the infant Defendants, to have said real estate sold, but he is advised that, under the law, this cannot be done except upon proper testimony by competent and disinterested witnesses.

Sixth: That he concedes the propriety of this Court, construing the Last Will and Testament of the said Anna S. Kemp, so that the rights of all the parties may be declared and enforced.

Seventh: That he admits the allegations contained in the Twelfth Paragraph of said Bill of Complaint.

Eighth: That he consents to the sale of the real estate, of which the said Anna S. Kemp died seized and possessed, and that the proceeds arising therefrom be distributed among the parties entitled thereto, according to their respective interests, as the same shall be declared by this Court, upon a proper construction of the Last Will and Testament of the said Anna S. Kemp, deceased.

WHEREFORE, having fully answered, he prays to be hence dismissed with his reasonable costs.
