

Hauver, it being also the end of the 59th line of the original tract called "The Range about the Three Miserable Knobs" and running thence N. 63 perches, S. 69 deg., E. 76 perches, S. 52 deg., W. 54 perches, S. 81 deg., W. 23.5 perches to place of beginning, containing 16 Acres, 3 Roods and 20 Perches of land, more or less.

And all that part of a tract of land described in the deed from Frederick A. Stotelmyer unto the said Harlan P. Stotelmyer, by deed dated March 25, 1905, and duly recorded in Liber S. T. H. No. 269, Folio 450, one of the Land records of Frederick County, and more particularly described in the Last Will and Testament of Daniel Stotelmyer, duly recorded in Will Record S.G.C. No. 1, Folio 486, in the office of the Recorder of Wills for Frederick County, as follows:

Also that part of a tract of land called "Resurvey on Almost Night", beginning for the same at the end of 25 perches on the 4th line of whole tract called "Resurvey on Almost Night" and running thence S. 20 deg., W. 35.32 perches, S. 10 deg., E. 34 perches, S. 16.75 deg., E. 23.28 perches, N. 61.5 deg., E. 1 perch, N. 16.75 deg., W. 41 perches; W. 14 perches; N. 15.90 perches; N. 2 deg. W. 29 perches; N. 71 deg., W. 9.5 perches, to the beginning, to contain 9 Acres and 26 Perches of Land.

The first four tracts are good mountain land and the last tract is meadow land.

That certified copies of the aforesaid deeds and will of Daniel Stotelmyer are filed herewith, marked "Exhibits A & B respectively, as a part of this Bill of Complaint, which with all other exhibits filed herewith it is prayed may be taken and considered as a part of this Bill.

2. That your Oratrix, as the widow of the said Harlan P. Stotelmyer, deceased, has filed in the Orphans Court for Frederick County, renunciation of the Will of the said Harlan P. Stotelmyer, Deceased, and has elected to take such share of the estate of the aforesaid deceased as allowed by law and she files herewith as part of this Bill certified copies of the said Will and renunciation, Marked Exhibits B-2 and B-3.

3. That the said Harlan P. Stotelmyer left as his heirs at law and next of kin his widow, Elizabeth C. Stotelmyer, your Oratrix, who has never remarried, who resides at R.F.D. Myersville, Md., and three living brothers and the heirs at law and next of kin of four deceased brothers, viz.,

- A. Daniel E. Stotelmyer, who resides in Philadelphia, Pa. and whose wife, Elizabeth Stotelmyer resides some place unknown to your Oratrix.
- B. Walter L. Stotelmyer, who resides, with his wife, Amy, on Route 4, Smithsburg, Md.
- C. Rufus Stotelmyer and Pearl Stotelmyer, his wife, who reside in Hagerstown, Md.
- D. Columbus C. Stotelmyer, a brother, died several years ago leaving as his heirs at law and next of kin:
 - a. Sarah Stotelmyer, his widow, who resides at Odd Fellows Home, Frederick, Md.
