- F. William Stotelmyer, a brother, who died several years ago, leaving as his heirs at law and next of kin:
- a. Ella Stotelmyer, his widow, who resides on Route 4, Smithsburg, Md.
 - b. Marvin Stotelmyer, a son, who went away from home quite a number of years ago and who is not thought to be married, but has not been definitely heard from since.
 - c. Wilbur Stotelmyer, a son, who resides with his wife, Helen Stotelmyer, on R.F.D., Smithsburg, Md.
 - d. Willie Stotelmyer, a son, who resides with his wife, Lillian Stotelmyer, on R.F.D. 4, Smithsburg, Md.
- G. Lemuel Stotelmyer, a brother, who died some years ago, leaving a widow, Anna Stotelmyer, who is supposed to reside some-where in West Virginia, and who left no children.

4. That your Oratrix is a resident of Frederick County, State of Maryland, while the residences of the other heirs at law and next of kin are as specified herein.

5. That the residence and premises herein before mentioned cannot be divided among the parties of interest without loss and injury and it would therefore be in the interest and to the benefit and advantage of all the parties to this cause that the said premises mentioned herein be sold and after the payment of the costs and expenses that the remainder be divided among the parties hereto according to their several rights and interests; that the proceeds of sale, for any remaindermen, if the Court shall so order, maybe invested under the orders of this Court for final distribution among the parties to this cause and among the parties of interest; that it would be advantageous to the parties concerned to sell the aforesaid premises and invest the proceeds of sale, after the payment of costs, so as to enure to the benefits of the same parties who would be entitled to the aforesaid land and premises finally, the same as if all the persons or parties would be entitled if the aforesaid contingency had happened at the date of the Decree of this Court; that the aforesaid tracts of land are in a somewhat run down condition, and the said tracts of land are subject to be sold for taxes and neither the aforesaid life tenant, your Oratrix, nor any of the other parties in interest feel able or justified in paying said taxes or making further effort to maintain the aforesaid tracts in their present condition.

TO THE END, THEREFORE,-

A. That the property mentioned and set forth in this Bill of Complaint may be decreed to be sold and after the payment of the costs and the expenses attending said sale, the proceeds remaining be distributed among the parties hereto according to their respective rights and interests.

B. That your Oratrix may have such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.
