Brandenburg, his wife, Witnesseth: That in Consideration of Forty Five Dollars and Seventy-five Cents (45.75) the receipt of which is hereby acknowledged, we do grant and convey in fee simple, unto Simon P. Kuhn and Savilia Kuhn all our right and title to the following parcel of land, Being part of the lands conveyed to the said John W. Brandenburg by Paul Kline by deed dated July 10, 1916, and beginning for the part hereby intended to be conveyed at a stake on the West side of the road at the beginning of the 4th line of a deed from C. O. Blickenstaff to Grover C. Kline and running with said line (1) N 75 W 39 perches to a stone (2) S 37 W 9 perches (3) S 71 E 41.5 perches to the road (4) N 21 E 7.33 perches to the beginning. Containing 1.83 Acres, more or less.
