(Filed Dec. 3, 1932)

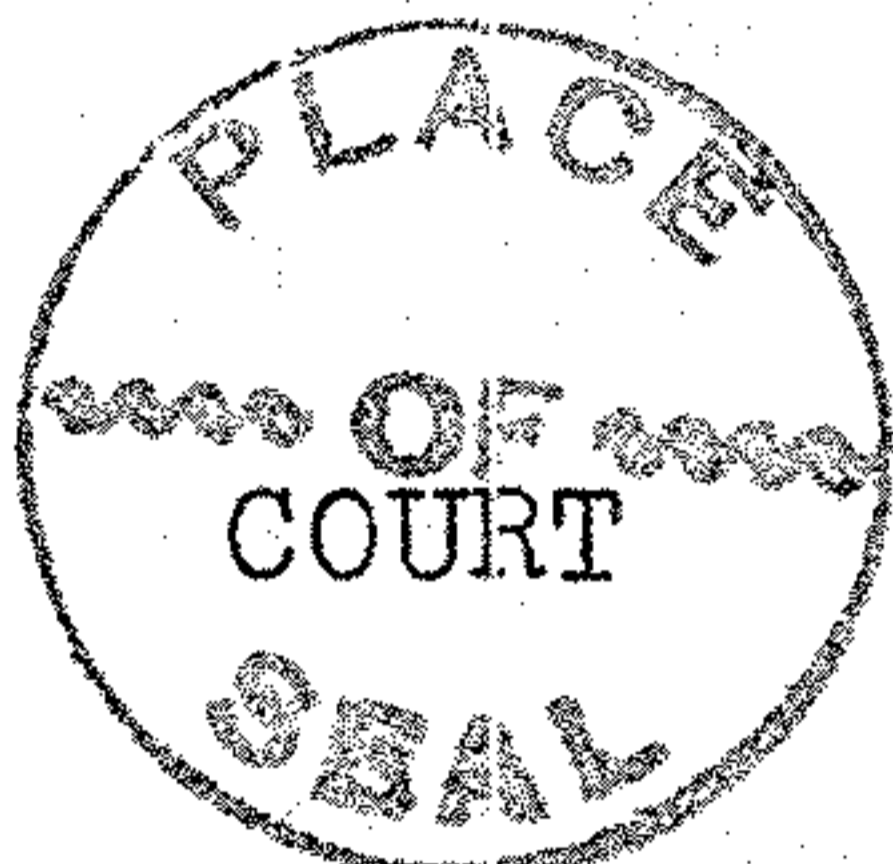
