W herefore your Complainants pray for the following relief:

2nd. That the proceeds arising from said sale may be distributed among the parties entitled thereto and for the payment of all costs and expenses.

3rd. And for such other and further relief as the nature of the case may require.

And your Complainants pray for the following process:

That the Writ of Subpoena may issue in the usual form for the purpose of summoning into Court Emma Carey and Raymond Lee Carey, her husband, Amalee Whip and Romy Whipp, her husband, Nina Hinkins and Wilbur Hinkins, her husband, Floyd Forrest and Laura Forrest, his wife, Theodore Forrest and Thelma Forrest, his wife, all of whom reside in Brunswick, Frederick County, Maryland, warning them to be and appear in your Honorable Court on some day certain to be named therein, either in person or by Solicitor, and show cause, if any they have, why the Decree prayed for should not be granted.
