Lewis by deed of David C. Winebrenner and wife, dated April 18, 1892, and duly recorded in Liber J. L. J. No. 3 folio 345, one of the Land Records of Frederick County, together with the improvements thereon and the rights thereunto appertaining.

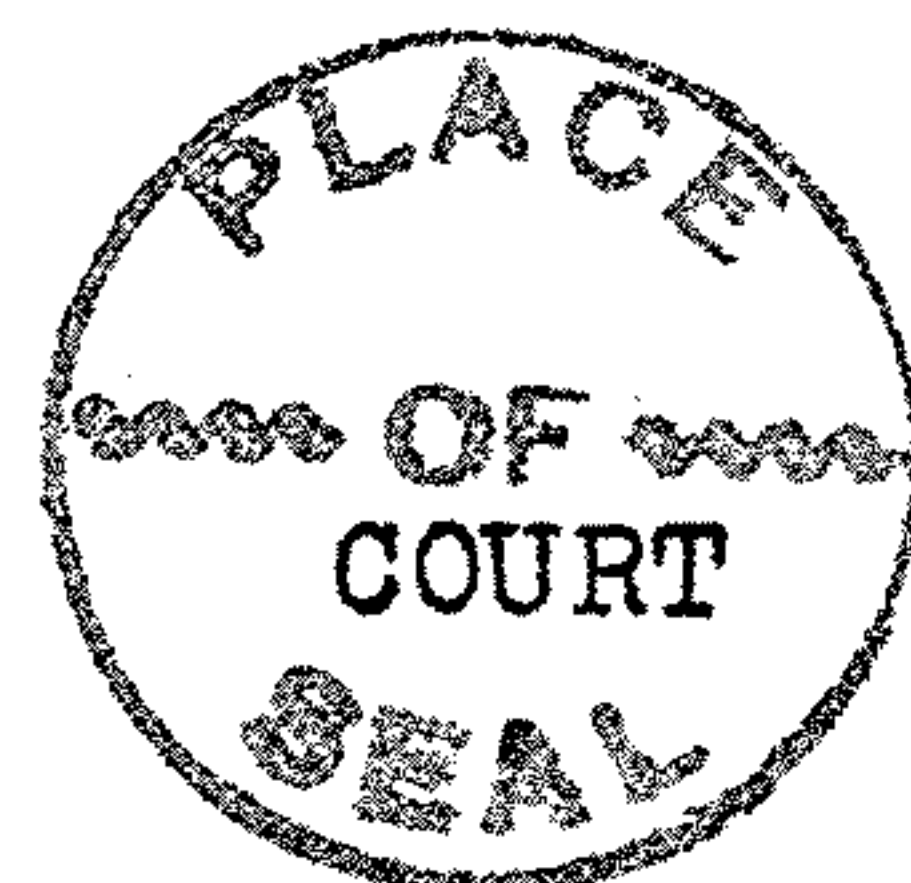
