To the Honorable the Judges of said Court:

The petition of Charles A. Gross, E. Lynch Gross and William Gross, executors of the estate of William L. Gross, deceased, respectfully represent unto your honors:-

1. That heretofore they intervened in the above entitle cause by filing a creditors petition so that they might out of the proceeds of sale of the real estate of the decedent, Edwin S. Forrest, obtain payment of their claim against him.
2.
